The course will consist of two sessions of beekeeping theory and one practical.

The theory sessions will be held at St Hilda's church hall in Carleton on Tuesday 7^{th} May and Tuesday 14^{th} May from 7-9 pm

The sessions will include

- An introduction to a beehive
 - o the frames on which the bees live and work
 - o including the brood chamber (where the queen lives)
 - o and the super (where the honey is stored)
- Introducing the clothing and tools used in beekeeping
- The lifecycle of honeybees
- The next steps to beekeeping

The practical session will be held Sundays 11-12 noon at the club apiary, Poulton-le-Fylde (dates and times to be arranged individually), bee suits will be provided.

The session will include

- An introduction to a working apiary
- Opening a beehive
- Finding the queen
- Looking at the brood (eggs, larvae and sealed brood)
- Differentiating between female and male sealed brood.
- Examining the nectar and any sealed honey
